DANCE PROCEDURES – STUDENT/PARENT CONTRACT

Albert Lea High School requests your assistance to ensure all students who choose to attend school dances follow the school policy outlined below. Your student has been informed of the rules and if they choose not to follow them, they will receive disciplinary consequences. This contract must be signed in order for your student to attend Albert Lea High School dances.

Dance Information

- Dances will be from 8:00–11:00 p.m.
- Doors will open at 8:00 p.m. and will close at 8:30 p.m. (unless pre-approved by an administrator)
- Once a student leaves, they may not re-enter.
- Students **MUST** have a student ID to enter the dance.
- The use of a breathalyzer is at the discretion of school administration.

Student Dance Behavior Expectations

Dances are an opportunity for students to socialize in a safe, supervised, and appropriate environment. Student behavior must display respect for all other students and staff.

- No inappropriate or dangerous dancing
- No crowd surfing
- No bending over
- No hands on the floor
- No mosh pits
- No grinding
- No inappropriate clothing
- Body parts should be adequately covered, even while dancing.
- Be respectful and kind to others.

Consequences

If you choose to break the rules, the consequences may include the following:

- Verbal warning
- Asked to leave; parents notified
- Loss of privileges to attend future dances
- Selling, possessing, or being under the influence of drugs or alcohol will result in immediate removal from the dance and suspension from school, with possible legal consequences.
