

STUDENT PARKING LOT RULES AND REGULATIONS

KEEP THIS PAGE FOR YOUR RECORDS. You will be expected to read and understand the driving/parking rules for the Albert Lea High School campus. Any violation of the driving/parking rules may result in a ticket being issued ranging from \$5-\$15, the loss of your parking permit, or the vehicle being booted at the owner's expense of \$10 or more. All motorized vehicles are subject to full provisions of these rules and applicable state laws. If you violate a rule, you will be asked to hand in your permit. Remember, it is a privilege to drive and park on the ALHS campus. Please give us your full cooperation. Any car parked on ALHS/District 241 property may be searched by school officials or law enforcement officers at school request. All motorized vehicles, drivers, and passengers are subject to full provisions of these rules and applicable state laws.

- **Permits will be rescinded without refund for violation of parking regulations.**
- **Albert Lea Area Schools Dist. 241 is not responsible for theft or damage to vehicles in parking lots.**
- **All vehicles must be registered and display a CURRENT ALHS parking permit with the permit number clearly visible at all times.** Any vehicle without a parking permit must be registered with the parking lot attendant for the day, the daily fee paid, and parked in the daily pass parking area.
- **Cars without a permit displayed and not registered with the parking lot attendant will receive a ticket and may be booted at the owner's expense of \$10, plus ticket fines.**
- **The driver registered with the school is responsible for the behavior of others in his/her vehicle, even if he/she is not present.**
- **It is recommended that students keep their doors locked at all times.**
- **Parking permits may only be used on cars registered to and driven by the student obtaining the permit.** Permits are not transferable to students or vehicles not listed on your application. Failure to abide by this will result in immediate loss of parking privileges at ALHS for the remainder of the semester.
- **Automobiles should be parked in the student parking lot in designated parking spaces within the yellow lines.** Cars parked in fire lanes, handicap zones, off-limit areas, or in an area blocking traffic will be tagged by police and towed at the owner's expense. Off-limit areas include all areas outside the student parking lot, including the staff parking lot.
- **Students are not to park in the visitors' lot at any time.**
- **Speed limit on all of ALHS property is 10 mph.**
- **All TRAFFIC LAWS are enforced.** Exhibition driving (squealing wheels, skidding, sliding, swaying, rapid acceleration/ deceleration, etc.) is prohibited and tickets will be issued.
- **Drivers and passengers are to obey Parking Lot Supervisor and school personnel at all times.**
- **Persons parking in the school parking lots do so at their own risk.**
- **Driving on sidewalks, lawns, or athletic fields is prohibited, and students will be required to pay restitution.**
- **Drivers should report accidents, vandalism, or theft to the Administration or Parking Lot Supervisor and, in some cases, the police.**
- **Students are not allowed to take other students out of school during the day without written parent permission.**
- **Students who violate any school policy risk having their parking permit suspended.**

Disciplinary Actions

First Offense: 2-week Suspension of Parking Permit
Second Offense: 9-week Suspension of Parking Permit
Third Offense: Parking Permit Revoked
