Age Restrictions:

You must be 19 in the state of Minnesota to take the GED Tests. If you are under 19 you can apply for an age waiver. Talk to Albert Lea Adult Basic Education for more information.

Cost: FREE WHILE FUNDING IS AVAILABLE

Each GED test costs \$30.00 in the state of Minnesota. You must register and pay online (ged.com). You may pay for tests one at a time. The total cost for all four tests is \$120.00. GED Practice Tests can be taken online for \$6.00 per subject.

Testing Sites:

The official GED Test will be administered at a GED Testing Facility of your choosing. To find the nearest testing facility visit GED.com. Albert Lea Adult Basic Education is a registered Pearson Vue Testing Center! Look for Albert Lea when you register!

Registering for the Test:

Go to www.ged.com to establish an account and register for the test!

Accommodations:

Accommodations may be available for individuals with disabilities. Accommodations might include additional testing time, individual testing area, additional breaks, etc. To apply for accommodations visit ged.com and create an account.

Test Scoring:

The GED® test will have a passing score of 150 on each test part. Therefore, you will need to reach a score of at least 150 on each part and a total score of 600 across the four-part battery in order to receive your GED® test credential.

- Below Passing: 100 – 144
- Passing Score: 145 – 200
